

§MO505.10 Nonproject activities

(a)(2)(iii) Engineering approval authority classes I through V (see §MO501.09) are the size and complexity of jobs normally worked on by Missouri NRCS personnel. Engineering services will not be committed for class VI, VII or VIII jobs without approval of the state conservationist. Recommendations from the Soil and Water Conservation District Board and the assistant state conservationist (FO) must be received before approval will be given.

(3)(i) Engineering designs prepared by non-NRCS professional engineers shall be sealed by the engineer. The first sheet of the detailed drawings shall include a statement that the design, drawings, and specifications meet current applicable NRCS standards. The statement shall read:

“NOTE: The drawings and specifications for this (conservation practice) have been prepared by (name of engineering firm) and meet the standards of the Natural Resources Conservation Service in Missouri.”

(3)(ii) NRCS approved standard detail drawings prepared by non-NRCS engineers for specific items of work shall be acknowledged on site specific drawings by the inclusion of a statement on the first sheet of the drawings for the items of work. This first sheet shall be sealed by the engineer. The statement shall read:

“NOTE: The drawings and specifications for this (Item of Work) are based on a design by (name of engineering firm) which conforms to technical standards of the Natural Resources Conservation Service in Missouri.”

(3)(iii) Non-NRCS engineers who prepare designs and monitor construction will review the checkout information and prepare “As Built” drawings. They shall sign a construction verification statement that the “AS BUILT” condition of the practice meets the original or revised drawings and specifications.
